Cultural Industries

Budget 2020-21

- Cultural Industries: \$39.5M
 - Decrease of 28% or \$15.1M*
 - Alberta Media Fund: \$30.9M
 - Decrease of 34% or \$15.8M*
- *This decrease is mostly attributed to a budget transfer to support the Film and Television Tax Credit, which has launched and is being administered by Economic Development, Trade and Tourism.

**SPG has transitioned to the Film and Television Tax Credit. 2020 funding allocation reflects existing commitments from prior years.

Key Initiatives

- Launch of Alberta Made Production Grant to maintain support to emerging producers and established producers working on smaller budget projects.
- Review and streamlining of operational funding for cultural industries organizations in order to reduce red tape.

- Working towards the creation of a creative partnerships program to leverage private investment in support of the cultural industries.
- The Jubilee and Jubilee Auditoria Society will expand programming like the Jube School, which provides students across Alberta with high-quality arts education experiences.
