Sport, Physical Activity and Recreation (SPAR) encourages Albertans to be more active by increasing awareness, alignment and coordination toward shared outcomes within the sport, physical activity and recreation sector to better inform and influence initiatives and sporting events at local, provincial and Pan-Canadian levels.

Budget 2020-21

- Total SPAR operating budget: \$21.7 M
 - Decrease of 14% or \$3.4 M
- SPAR Grants: \$15.1 M

Key Initiatives

- Ongoing operational funding to over 120 Sport, Physical Activity and Recreation organizations.
- Continued funding of high performance athletes through Podium Alberta.
- Continued support for the Alberta Future Leaders Program providing sport, arts, recreation and leadership development in Indigenous Communities.
- Continued support of the Alberta Games, including the 2020 Alberta Summer Games in Lethbridge.
 - The province also funded the successful 2020 Alberta Winter Games held recently in Airdrie.
- Creation of the Ambassador for Sport and Active Living to encourage Albertans to become more physically active.
